Professor Bang, Professor of Medical Oncology, has been working for Seoul National University College of Medicine and Hospital since 1986. He graduated from Seoul National University College of Medicine in 1979. He is certified in the specialties of internal medicine and hematology/medical oncology. He was Director of Cancer Research Institute of Seoul National University from 2000 to 2006, the President of the Korean Cancer Study Group from 2006 to 2008, the Chairman of the Korean Association for Clinical Oncology from 2008 to 2010, the vice-President of Korean National Enterprise for Clinical Trials from 2009 to 2104, the Chairman of Department of Internal Medicine from 2010 to 2014, the Chairman of the Korean Cancer Association from 2012 to 2014, Director of Clinical Trials Center from 2009 to 2017 Feb, and the President of Biomedical Research Institute from 2013 to 2017 Feb. Dr. Bang has co-authored more than 440 papers in SCI-indexed international journals including *New England Journal of Medicine* and *Lancet*. He is primarily interested in the development of new anticancer therapeutics, both clinical and translational, especially in gastric cancer. He is the Principal Investigator of a number of international clinical trials including ToGA study, CLASSIC study, SHINE study, GOLD study, JAVELIN Gastric 300 study, and KEYNOTE 585 study.
